

Tewkesbury Borough Plan 2011 – 2031

Adoption Statement

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulations 17, 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended), and Regulation 16 of the Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes Regulations 2004, that Tewkesbury Borough Council formally adopted the Tewkesbury Borough Plan 2011 – 2031 on 8 June 2022.

Adoption of the Tewkesbury Borough Plan 2011 – 2031 has the effect of revoking all ‘saved’ policies from the Tewkesbury Borough Plan to 2011 (adopted in 2006).

The Tewkesbury Borough Plan 2011 – 2031 was the subject of an independent examination conducted by David Reed BSC DipTP DMS MRTPI, an Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State. The examination included public hearing sessions (held remotely) in February and March 2021.

The Inspector’s Report was issued on 12 April 2022 and concluded that the Plan as submitted is sound and legally compliant, subject to the Inspector’s Main Modifications pursuant to Section 20(5) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004.

The adopted Tewkesbury Borough Plan 2011 – 2031 incorporates all Main Modifications set out in the appendix to the Inspector’s Report, as well as Additional Modifications agreed by the Council.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the Tewkesbury Borough Plan 2011 - 2031 may make an application to the High Court, under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate power of the local planning authority and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made within six weeks from the date of adoption by the Council (i.e. not later than **20 July 2022**).
