

**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT) ORDER
1995**

DIRECTION MADE UNDER ARTICLE 4(2)

WHEREAS THE COUNCIL FOR THE BOROUGH OF TEWKESBURY (hereinafter called "the Council") being the appropriate Planning Authority within the meaning of Article 4(6) of Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 is satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule below should not be carried out on any land within the area edged red on the attached plan being land situated within the Great Washbourne Conservation Area, Gloucestershire (hereinafter referred to as "the said land")

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of powers conferred upon it by Article 4(2) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 **HEREBY DIRECT** that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the description set out in the Schedule hereto

The provisions of Article 3 of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 shall not apply to development in the following Class being a Class specified in Schedule 2 of the said Order:-

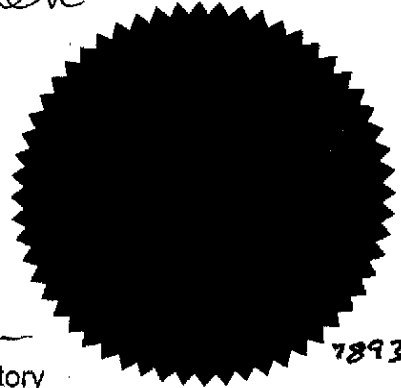
